

GOOD PRACTICE MANUAL FOR CULTURAL VISITS AND CONSERVATION OF HISTORICAL HERITAGE

Note down or gather any details that could be of relevance (such as vehicle registration numbers), and contact the authorities.


DO NOT TOUCH



Archaeological remains may typically be found anywhere in Menorca's historical heritage buildings, both within and in the surrounding area. During cultural visits, do not remove any fragment on the ground from its context, irrespective of the type of material (stones, bones, pottery, metal). Leave archaeological digs to the professionals!


RESPECT AT ALL TIMES






The bulk of Menorca's historical heritage structures are fragile, and their intactness is therefore vulnerable. If during a visit to such places or archaeological sites you note any significant alteration, such as collapsed structures, rubbish, graffiti or other situations that could compromise the preservation and appearance of a monument, please contact the authorities.

UNDERSEA SURPRISES



Menorca's historical heritage comprises elements found both on land and on the seabed, whether or not they have been catalogued. If you happen to find some object or unknown structure, whether on dry land or at sea, please notify the relevant authorities immediately. Despite their landmark status, many of the structures that make up Menorca's historical heritage are subject to erosion and deterioration. During cultural visits, follow the signposted routes, and if none are marked, make sure you walk along well-worn tracks. If a structure collapses, you could be badly hurt!

EVERYTHING IN ITS PLACE



Much of the island's historical heritage can be found in rural areas or natural settings, where there are no refuse collection points or regular maintenance service. Use the bins provided to dispose of any rubbish you may accumulate, and if there are none available, keep it with you until you find one. Respect the environment!
